ignition: the device that starts a car's engine



**Synonyms:** burn, enkindle, fire, inflame (also enflame), kindle, light, torch.

**Discussion:** Refer back to the root word, ignire "set on fire," from ignis "fire". What prefixes and suffixes can be added to this word and how does the new word change?

**Sample Sentence:** Before heading out into the rain, the girl jumped into her car and put her key into the ignition. "Do I really want to be driving out in this rain?" she thought.

notion: an idea or belief



**Synonyms:** idea, belief, concept, conception, conviction, opinion, view, thought, impression, image, perception, mental picture, assumption

**Discussion:** When teachers introduce new notions in the classroom, what would you like them to do?

**Sample Sentence:** His heart leaped at the **notion** of getting an extra day to work on his school project.

**CIF [Writing to Learn]** What is your notion of the ideal way to spend your summer vacation?

Hacer pucheros

Purse: to draw one's lips into a tight circle or line



**Synonyms:** pucker, crease, wrinkle, tighten

**Discussion:** What are some ways we communicate with facial expressions?

**Sample Sentence:** The father pursed his lips when his daughter walked in late after her curfew.
