
Systematically

according to a fixed plan or system; methodically.


Synonyms: consistently, methodically, regularly

<u>Discussion:</u> How would you work systematically to solve a math equation?

Sample Sentence: We searched systematically for evidence.

Grisly



horror

To cause horror or disgust

Synonyms: gruesome, ghastly, frightful, horrid, horrifying

Discussion: How do you feel when you watch grisly crime movies/shows?

Sample Sentence: The town of Riverdale was shaken by a series of grisly crimes.

<u>CIF [Think-Pair-Share]</u>: What shows or movies have you seen that are like Riverdale that also have grisly crimes? Turn to a partner and share your response. Be ready to share your response with the class.

Concentration Camps



Campos de concentracion

a place where large numbers of people, especially political prisoners or members of persecuted minorities, are deliberately imprisoned in a relatively small area with inadequate facilities.

Synonyms: labor camp, prison camp

Discussion: What type of people would be in these types of camps?

<u>Sample Sentence:</u> She ended up dying in a *concentration camp*, just a few months before she would have been liberated.

CIF [Writing to Learn]: What do you know about concentration camps? Be ready to share your response with the class.

Genocide



genocidio

the deliberate killing of people who belong to a particular racial, political, or cultural group

Synonyms: blood bath, massacre, slaughter

Discussion: What is the biggest genocide in history?

Sample Sentence: Hitler ordered the genocide of all Jews.

<u>CIF [Think-Pair-Share]</u>: What other genocide do you know about that has occurred in history? Be ready to share your response with the class.

Holocaust



holocausto

destruction or slaughter on a mass scale, especially caused by fire or nuclear war

Synonyms: conflagration, fire, inferno

<u>Discussion</u>: What type of fears do you think prisoners of the Holocaust had?

Sample Sentence: The museum is devoted to the Holocaust.

<u>CIF [Think-Write-Pair-Share]</u>: What knowledge do you have about the Holocaust? Turn to a partner and share your response. Be ready to share your sentence with the class.
